ITEPP GRADUATE STUDENT PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

I _____ hereby request an extension of my previous ITEPP application to cover my graduate studies in _____.

In order to assist students to be successful at Humboldt State University, the Indian Tribal & Educational Personnel Program has found that the following practices are key elements to assist students in reaching their academic goals in a timely manner.

1. I understand that email is an official communication method of the university and that I will check in with the on-line Student Center to stay up to date.
2. I understand that it is my responsibility to consult with my **ITEPP Advisor at least bi-weekly** (by email, phone, or personal visit). By keeping your ITEPP advisor updated and informed of your situation, they will be able to better inform you of what options are available. Most issues have timelines, let your advisor know of any issues before there are fewer options available.
3. As an ITEPP Grad Student, I understand that the ITEPP Director/Advisor will monitor my academic performance and program participation. Mid-semester academic performance evaluations will be sent to my instructors in an on-going effort to monitor my attendance, coursework, expected grades, etc.
4. I understand that it is my responsibility to work with my ITEPP advisor to assist me in successfully completing my academic plan and maintaining the required grade point average. Most graduate programs require a minimum of a 3.0 GPA to remain in good standing in their programs.
5. I give permission for my name, tribal affiliation/political status, photos, and academic achievements to be used in ITEPP public relations announcements and newsletters. _____(initial)
6. I grant complete access to any and all campus information about me necessary to perform ITEPP's academic support and mentoring role, including but not limited to: financial aid, course grades, mid-semester evaluations, disability information, disciplinary actions, counseling appointment attendance, and any awards. This information, held in your file, will be protected by university standard FERPA rules of disclosure.
